BUYING AND SHIPPING TIPS

No items requiring refrigeration

Keep weight limited

Check Wal-mart, Rite Aid for travel size items

No Shampoo – Containers will break – messy

Female personal toiletries

No gel or aerosol shaving products

Avoid highly scented items as they attract bugs

Place items in Ziploc bags. Place a card in each package with your name, address and recipient's content listing.

3 MOST REQUESTED ITEMS

1. Cigarettes (hard to obtain in combat theatre)

Includes chewing tobacco, cigars and roll your own supplies.

2. Phone Cards

3. Charge Cards – Visa or Master Charge

ALSO REQUESTED

Boot Sox – black or green

T Shirts, brown

Flea Collars (they attach them to their belt loops fleas and ticks are everywhere)

Inflatable kids pool (great to cool off in)

Shaving cream in a tube with a screw top – NO fragrance (Brands include Kiss My Face, Alba Botanica, and Tom's of Main)

Disposable Razors men's and women's

Powdered Gatorade or similar drinks

Ramen Noodles Canned Nuts

Batteries – AA, AAA, and D

Magazines Sports, hunting and fishing, motorcycles, cars (NO CURRENT EVENT OR X RATED MAGAZINES Newsweek, Time, U.S. News & Report, etc.)

Posters / Calendars to personalize their quarters

External hard drive memory sticks 1 – 2 GB USB (empty)

Stationery supplies – Paper & envelopes, pens. NO STAMPS

Homemade cookies – NO CHOCOLATE – it is dehydrating

Gum breath mints (Ziploc it)

iPODS and earphones

Miniature hand held fans & batteries

Greeting cards made at home, hand written letters, art work drawn by Kids

Books – paper back only, Mysteries or other genres.

Q-Tips & Pipe Cleaners (for weapons and ears)

Ivory Soap (it floats)

Bug repellent – DEET or Deep Woods Off for those in the middle east

Beef Jerky (pork not allowed by Islam) Tuna Lunch – to - go packs

Coffee -- ground in small packages

Games – crossword books etc.

Sunscreen, waterproof sealed in Ziploc, Lip protection, Aloe Vera lotion, foot powder, eye drops, Tylenol, Aspirin, Motrin etc, Moleskin for sore feet and throat lozenges

Sunglasses, goggle type

Mail order catalogs (troops can shop on line and have items sent to their home)

Ziploc bags – Freezer type / quart and gallon sizes

Milk – Parmalat www.parmalat.com or Gossner www.gossner.com or health food stores.

Wipes – Hands, glasses, baby – best if packed in small amounts in Ziplocs

Tooth brushes, floss (soldiers give these to the kids, ask you dentist to donate).

Kleenex (small packs) Toilet paper NO rolls – Wal-Mart has small travel size, use these items for packing around other items.
