## TRUSTEES CORNER

This is an alert to a serious possible problem facing the Lodge. When the Lodge was being built, there was a shortage of funds and several members stepped up with additional funds. They were given a promissory note for those funds, the intent was to repay their loans at a future date. That date is almost upon us and we simply don't have enough money to cover those promissory notes. The dates the notes are due start in 2012.

Since the Sierra Room is (for all intents and purposes) done and beautiful, I suggest we start raising money to pay off these notes! Any ideas would be appreciated.

We are still trying to get the outside lights working properly. Richard Mills, our Facilities Manager, is expecting additional electrical bids and the trustees are looking forward to an answer.

Dave Stackpole has changed the security codes for the Lodge. He will be issuing new keys shortly also.

The Lodge Floor approved the purchase of security cameras to be installed around the inside perimeter of the Lodge. These will be installed as soon as possible.

We now have a new alarm company with the new alarm installed. This will ultimately save us on monthly charges in the future.

We still need volunteers to help clean the inside lodge, i.e. walls, floors, etc. If we have enough people, this should not take much time so think about stepping up, please.

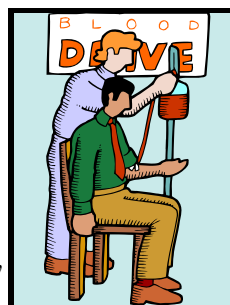


